Habitat

Rabbits should have a safe and secure habitat away from direct sunlight and drafts. It is important your habitat has enough room for your rabbit to eat, sleep and play. Rabbits love extra room to roam so they will benefit from a play yard that is a safe and secure exercise area. Consider connecting multiple Kaytee® Open Living™ habitats to increase your pet's living area. Your rabbit's habitat should be cleaned at least once a week.



Diet

Rabbits are considered herbivores in nature, which means they primarily feed on grasses and plants. As household pets, make sure to feed diets high in fiber to support their overall health. - Rabbits are pretty smart; they can be trained to go to the bathroom in a litter box!
- If a Rabbit is younger than 6 months (juvenile), it is recommended they eat Alfalfa Hay.
- If a male and female are housed together, they can have litters of 4 to 10 bunnies.
- As pets, same-sex pairs work well if spayed or neutered.
- Rabbit's teeth continually grow. Provide your pet a variety of chew textures, toys, and hay to help keep teeth trim.
